Climate Mysteries of the Ice Age

4. **Why was it typical during the Ice Age that animals and plants which preferred warm climates lived together with those preferring cold weather?**
5. **Much of Alaska and Siberia were not covered.**

An Ice Age Cause by the Flood

- Global Flood resulted in warmed oceans from pole to pole
- Warm North Sea supplied warm moist air
- Winter mid-continents were cold
- Storms picked up sea moisture- carried inland
- More snow fell each winter than could melt in the summer –built up almost 2 miles of ice, sea level drops up to 300 feet – *Tower of Babel time to Exodus*
- After about 500 years the North Sea froze over
- Summer now melted more ice than fell in winter
- Ice Sheet melted back in about 200 years
